Becoming a Certified Paverpol Instructor (CPI) is a **great way to** generate additional income while doing what you love to do; sharing your knowledge with other people who want to learn to work and create with Paverpol.

General Information:

By taking the 2-day Certified Paverpol Instructors (CPI) course, it will provide you with basic product knowledge and techniques that will form the foundation of your creative Paverpol journey. During the two (2) days, you will make three projects and learn to work with the core Paverpol products. In addition, your Master Trainer will provide and guide you with tips and advice on starting your business as a Paverpol Instructor.

It is extremely important for us to ensure that you will continue to receive support During and After the course. We want you to be successful in your Paverpol journey to becoming a CPI AND starting your own independent creative business. Your Regional Director and Master Trainer can help you with some issues that you need help with or give you advice on techniques. Lastly, you also have the support of a full community of CPI's within Canada to support you with questions, concerns and techniques. Please note that if you are taking an on-line course from within Canada or internationally, this will not be recognized as a CPI training course by Paverpol Canada.

Benefits of Becoming a Certified Instructor

Once you have "**fully completed all the requirements of your training course**", you will be awarded and recognized as a Certified Paverpol Instructor and are entitled to receive the following:

- 20% (MSRP) discount, as per the conditions of the required minimum purchase
- Link to your website via www.paverpol.ca (not required for Level 1, but required for Level 2), but highly encouraged to create a website dedicated to your Paverpol based studio)

- Access to the Paverpol Private CPI Facebook Group. This is a 'private' group and only certified instructors can have access. It is a safe place to ask questions, share information, ask advice and find tutorials. It is a very active group!

Prerequisite:

It is mandatory to have taken at least three (3) full-day workshops with a Certified Paverpol Instructor (CPI) or have made at least five (5) sculptures on your own (photos and/or CPI instructor name(s) will be requested).

FAQs:

What Projects are made during the CPI Course?

Three projects will be made during the 2-Day Course, in addition to completing final projects on your own to demonstrate your understanding of Paverpol techniques and methodologies. Through your learnings, you'll be able to adapt these to your classes.

Project 1 – Basic figure with hands and feet (can be standing/sitting). CPI candidates learn to make their own 60/40 wire frame with introduction to the importance of infrastructure and reinforcement of armatures. Foiling technique. You will learn the T-shirt wrap technique and dress with PaverCotton and/or Stockinette, etc. Dry Brushing technique will be demonstrated.

Project 2 – Bird – Paverplast technique. Exposure to using Relief Decoration/Wrappers/paper towels, etc. Learning how to mix PaverColor with Paverpol and Josefine Varnish.

Project 3 – A canvas sampler. Sampler will be on a stretched canvas (or on a wood canvas). This will demonstrate the dry brushing technique and use of Relief Decoration, Stockinette, PaverCotton, Wrappers, PaverScrub, PaverSands, clays made with the Paverpol products, and ArtStone with PaverColor.

Final Projects - Demonstrated Knowledge and Technical Evaluation. You will be required to make a minimum of three (3) finished statues on your own within the next six (6) months. These finished statues will be reviewed, evaluated and approved by the Review Team in order to be recognized for the CPI designation.

Is there a discount teaching package available for purchase during the course?

Yes, there is an option to purchase (a one-time discount) of approximately 25% during the CPI course. The special instructor's package is so that you can start working on your "at home" projects to complete your certification.

What is included in the 2-Day Level 1 – Certified Instructor's course?

- You will get intensive instruction on how to work with the core Paverpol products and suitable technical applications.
- All Paverpol products will be provided for the course.
- Your Trainer will provide you with the Level 1 Course Handout.
- Ongoing support and feedback with your Regional Director and Master Trainer. They are only an email or phone call away.

What happens when you are not teaching anymore or you are taking a break?

It is best to advise your Regional Director as soon as possible. Your website listing from the Paverpol Canada website (if applicable) will be removed until further notice. You can make arrangements with the Regional Director should you wish to start teaching again. As a recognized CPI, you will continue to receive your discount, if you purchase at the minimum requirements.
