General Information:

By taking the 2-day Level 2 Certified Paverpol Instructors (CPI) course, it will provide you with additional product knowledge and advanced techniques in anatomy and infrastructure to ensure that all your bases and structures will withstand weather conditions and gravity. This course will further advance your creative Paverpol journey. During the two (2) days, you will make two (2) projects with an emphasis on infrastructure.

It is extremely important for us to ensure that you will continue to receive support During and After this course. Your Regional Director and Master Trainer will continue to help you with any issues that you need help with and/or give you advice on techniques. Lastly, you will continue to have the support of a full community of CPI's within Canada. Please note that if you are taking an on-line certification course from within Canada or internationally, this will not be recognized as a CPI course by Paverpol Canada.

Benefits of Becoming a Certified Instructor

Once you have fully completed your course and are awarded and recognized as a Level 2 Certified Paverpol Instructor, you will be entitled to receive the following:

FAQ:

What Projects are made during the CPI Course?

Two (2) projects will be made during the 2-Day Course, in addition to completing final projects on your own to demonstrate your understanding of Paverpol techniques and methodologies. Through your learnings, you'll be able to adapt these to your classes. There will be some pre-work required by the student prior to the first class

Project 1 – Large Heron. CPI candidates learn to make their own large bird wire frame with introduction to the importance of infrastructure, balance and reinforcement of the armature. The Master Trainer will provide the base and legs; the student will may be required to pre-cut the “guide wires” for shaping of body and head.

Project 2 – Ballerina. Focus on armature and Paverplast “smoothing” technique and/or “sand” technique. Student may be required to initially bring a simple one-layer of tinfoil armature, WITHOUT any “muscle” sculpting or shaping. The head can be shaped by the student prior to the course. We will focus and discuss anatomy in further detail, in addition to infrastructure and reinforcement. Base to be discussed with Master Trainer prior to the first day of class. Wrappers, granite technique and/or sand and paverplast will be focused on.

Final Projects - Demonstrated Knowledge and Technical Evaluation. You will be required (at home) to finish dry-brushing your Heron and Ballerina. As a “test” for infrastructure, you will need to make a Heron AND a Large Garden armature on your own for the Master Trainer to evaluate within the next three (3) months. These armatures will be reviewed, evaluated for infrastructure and balance, to be approved by the Paverpol Review Team in order to be recognized for the Level 2 CPI designation.

Is there a discount teaching package available for purchase?

Yes, there is an option to purchase, at a one-time discount of approximately 30%. This special discount is so that you can finish your “at home” projects to compliment your portfolio of foundations and larger armatures.

What is included in the 2-Day Level 2 – Certified Instructor's course?

- You will get intensive instruction on infrastructure, balance and anatomy with suitable technical applications. Outlines of armature dimensions will be provided.
- Paverpol supplies/materials will be provided for the course, unless otherwise indicated by the Master Trainer.
- Ongoing support and feedback with your Regional Director and Master Trainer.

What happens when you are not teaching anymore or you are taking a break?

It is best to advise your Regional Director/Distributor as soon as possible. Your website listing from the Paverpol Canada website (if applicable) will be removed until further notice. You can make arrangements with the Regional Director should you wish to start teaching again. As a recognized CPI, you will continue to receive your discount, if you purchase at the minimum requirements.
